

PAST, BUT NOT FORGOTTEN WORSHIPFUL MASTER

I wasn't aware of it at the time, but the day I was initiated an entered apprentice of Solomon lodge in late 1999, set the stage for my masonic career. I really didn't know what to think while I was under that blindfold, only to say I was apprehensive. However, toward the end of the ceremony I was provided a chair and sat down in the middle of the lodge room while a brother presented me a lecture that explained what I just experienced. The two subsequent degrees were good, but the EA degree stayed with me to this day. By 2004 I became worshipful master of the greatest lodge in northeast Florida. Because of this fact, I wanted to make the most of my year by doing something special that would have lasting memories, so I started some hard thinking that eventually took me back to my youth around 1955. One of the ty programs of that era was titled "This Is Your Life" with Ralph Edwards. Mr. Edwards would take well known people and chronicle their life with others from their past talking behind a curtain. The program was very popular, so I wanted to create something much like it. I picked three of our elderly brothers and with the help from their wives we secretly compiled a background. What I found out about these three brothers was eye opening astonishing.

> 1. Worshipful Henry Herr was a 3-time past master, but long before that he was a decorated Army Air Corp bombardier over Omaha beach June 6, 1944 (D-day). I located the pilot of the b-26, but he was to frail to travel. He wrote a letter for the occasion that explained the 81 bombing missions they completed during that campaign.....

2. Brother Hugh Powell I found out was one of then presidential candidate George Wallace's campaign managers in the mid 60's. Hugh went on to carry on his father's insurance business which is still in operation to this day.....

3. Brother George turner who's lifetime escapades and colorful demeaner is legendary to this day. While he never held a chair in the lodge he diligently promoted the lodge's history.

The point I'm trying to put forth is the fact that you never really know who you're sitting beside during activity within our fraternity. We have brothers from all walks of life, and this association should be a continuing legacy for us all to cherish. It is my hope that when I lay down my working tools and travel to that house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens, those I leave behind in lodge will remember me, not so much as a <u>PM or PPDGM</u>, but as a "**BROTHER**"


