


#### Improvement in Community Involvement:

## Celebrating The 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Solomon Lodge No. 20 F&AM January 10<sup>th</sup> at 3pm

The 175th celebration of the founding of Solomon Lodge No. 20 F&AM was kicked off at 3pm, the same time 175 years ago that the Lodge was formed, and featured Presentation of the Colors by the Scottish Rite Guardsmen, National Anthem by Hansford Joiner PM, historical perspectives by Master of Ceremonies Prof. Clayton Vandiver, Jr. PM, history of the Lodge by Robby Stokes PDDGM, an address by W.: Ben Flanagan, invocation and prayers by Sam Bennett PDDGM, and the presentation of a commemorative historical marker (shown on the previous page) unveiled by Calvin Oglesby.

R.:W.: Robby Stokes PDDGM, on behalf of the Barnett Museum and Preservation Society, Inc. with the assistance of W.: Ben Flanagan, unveiled the historical marker placed in front of the Lodge on 1<sup>st</sup> Street adding the Mansion to the Florida Heritage Site registry and giving anyone passing by a wealth of historic information on the Barnett Mansion and the proud Freemasons who cherish and preserve that iconic architectural treasure. The Barnett Mansion has been part of the Jacksonville community since the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. It has been a quintessential part of the Masonic family since the 1940's.
